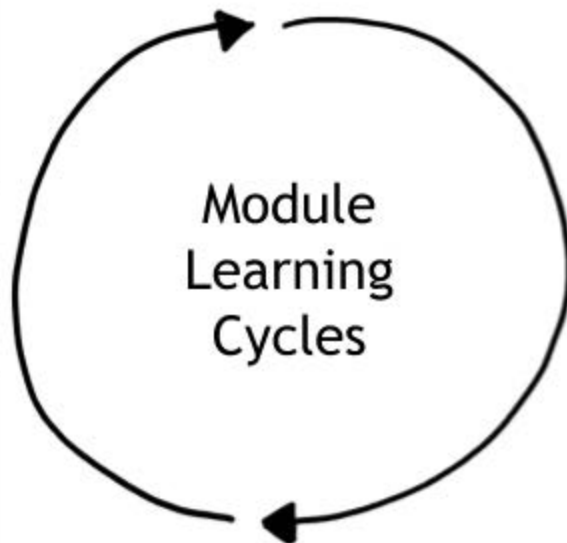


Advisory

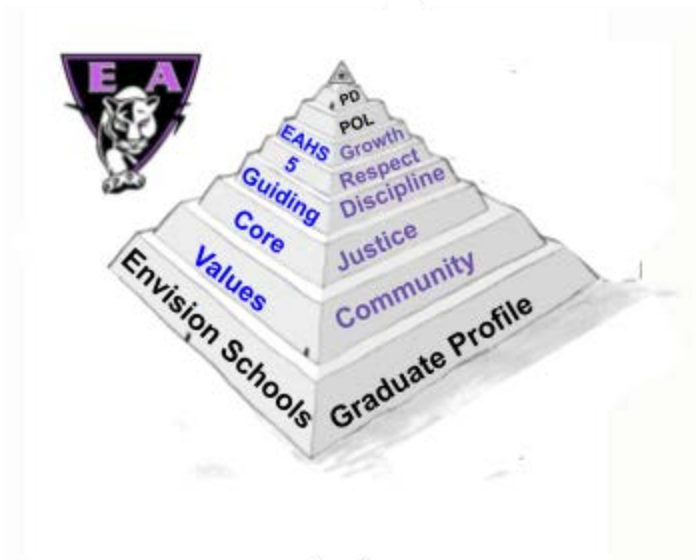
