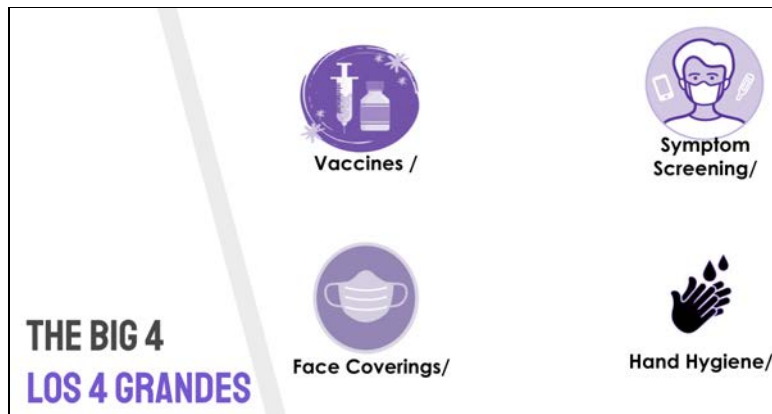

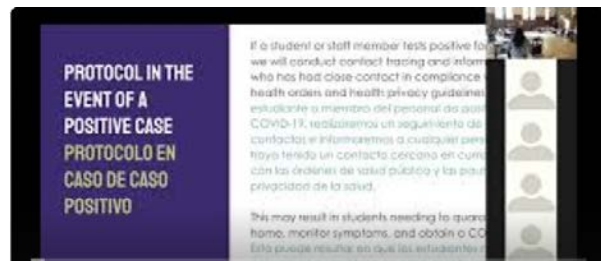
COVID-19 Updates

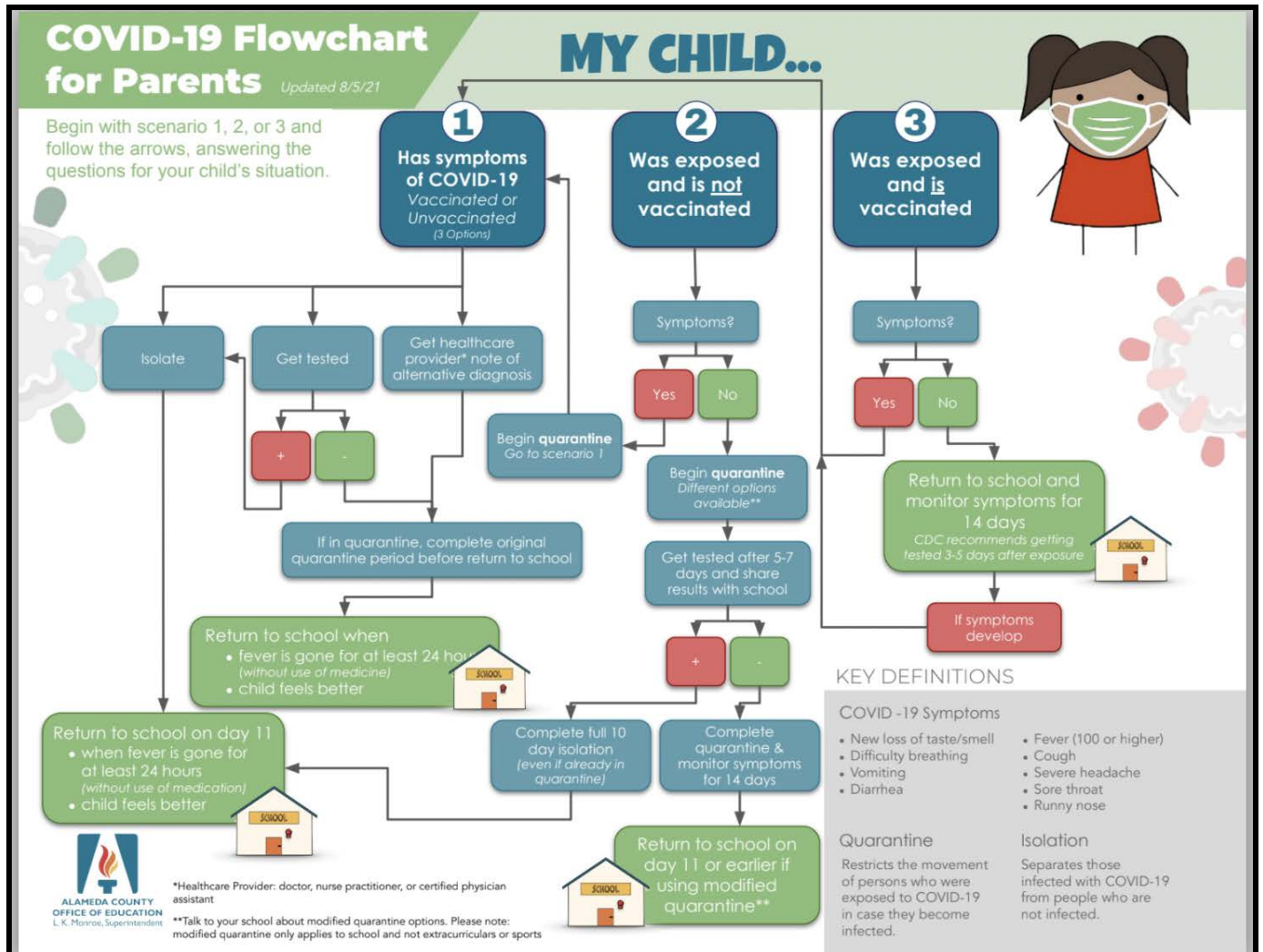
